This Botswana safari visits three countries, [Botswana](#), [Namibia](#) and [Zimbabwe](#). The safari begins in [Kasane](#), northern Botswana, with return flights out of either Kasane or [Victoria Falls](#).

You'll explore the [Zambezi Region](#) of Namibia, visit with the bushmen of the [Central Kalahari](#), pole through the [Okavango Delta](#) on a dug out mokoro canoe, search for the Big Five in [Moremi Game Reserve](#) and [Chobe National Park](#) and experience the magic of a photographic cruise on the stunning Chobe River. The safari wraps up with three unforgettable days in Victoria Falls – plenty of time to explore this natural wonder at your leisure, with a Zambezi boat trip included, and optional white-water rafting, elephant encounters and helicopter flights.

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## Day 1-2 - Chobe River Photo Safari



Explore the Chobe River on an unforgettable photographic safari. From photo-friendly boats and assisted by the world-renowned Pangolin photo team, you'll get to see wildlife from a whole new perspective. Being low to the water allows for some exceptional photo opportunities. Professional equipment can be supplied if required. Overnight at a unique, new lodge overlooking the Chobe River and its flood plains.

## Day 3 - Zambezi Region (Caprivi Strip)



Get acquainted with your safari vehicle and head to Namibia's Kwando River in Nkasa Rupara National Park to discover one of the best camps in Southern Africa. The great explorer Dr David Livingstone spent several months in this area in 1856, and described the area in his memoirs as "the garden of Eden". Visit the onsite Livingstone Museum.

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## Days 4-5 - Okavango Panhandle



Routing along the Zambezi Region (formerly known as the “Caprivi Strip”), we spend two leisurely days on the banks of the mighty Okavango River. With its origins deep in the Angolan highlands, it’s the main watercourse feeding the Okavango Delta. The birdlife is fantastic on these crystal-clear waters and by boat you’ll be able to get in close proximity to a huge number of species, including the African fish eagle and, with luck, the very rare Pel’s fishing owl, which is often found in the area.

## Days 6-7 - Central Kalahari



A unique element of this safari is a two day visit to the Central Kalahari, with a chance to interact with the San bushmen who call this vast, wonderful region their home.

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## Day 8 - Mokoro delta safari



Driving north from the Kalahari, we'll enter the Okavango Delta, a vast and unique water wonderland and arguably Botswana's best wildlife area. The next two days will be spent in search of the wide variety of animals and birds that this remarkable region is renowned for. You'll explore the reed channels and floodplains in a mokoro (traditional dugout canoe), while absorbing the beauty of this magnificent area. Overnight at a safari camp deep in the Delta.

## Days 9-10 - Moremi Game Reserve



Moving north through Moremi Game Reserve, you'll follow the historic routes of the early Bechuanaland pioneers into the Moremi/Khwai Concession Area. This stunning region is known for its prolific and diverse wildlife and day 9 will be spent at one of the newest lodges in the area for some well-earned R&R. The next day you'll have the opportunity to

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explore the area at your leisure, with a picnic lunch in the bush. Overnight under the stars at a magnificent wild safari camp.

## Day 11 - Savuti and Chobe National Park



On day 11, we'll continue north into the iconic Savuti region, one of Africa's best-known big game areas. Savuti is a place of enchantment and beauty, and boasts one of the greatest concentrations of animals in Southern Africa. We'll overnight at a safari camp overlooking a water pan and sip sundowners as animals congregate for their evening drink.

## Days 12-14 - Victoria Falls



Leaving Chobe and our safari vehicles behind, we'll transfer into Zimbabwe to visit the magnificent Victoria Falls. Lunch on the veranda of the iconic "Vic Falls Hotel" overlooking the gorge and the historic railway bridge, followed by a boat ride on the Zambezi. Enjoy

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three nights' luxury accommodation in Victoria Falls, with optional additional activities, including white water rafting down the Zambezi Gorge, canoeing on the upper Zambezi River, elephant encounters and helicopter flights over Victoria Falls. Return flights out of Victoria Falls or Kasane.
